

2014 - 2015 BUILDING & GROUNDS REPORT

Maintenance:

- Renovations were completed in the upstairs pub (new painting, lighting)
- New energy efficient LED lights in the parking lot and on the building exterior were installed
- Parking lot was professionally cleaned and potholes filled
- Exterior doors were painted

Building Renewal:

- A sub-committee was formed early in the New Year to oversee and direct the design work for renovating the building to make it properly barrier-free, provide more natural light, more functional space (particularly the main floor) and a safer more friendly building to enter and be in.
- Newstudio Architecture were hired to complete the concept design work. Their fee for this work is \$14,800. The work is approximately 30% complete and we expect to have the concept design work completed early in the New Year. Drawings of the planned renovations will be posted to the community league website and an open house will be held to share the designs and gather feedback. Based on feedback on the design from the community consultation changes to the design will be reviewed by the committee.
