Scona Road & Saskatchewan Drive Intersection Improvement

As part of the 2020 construction program, the City of Edmonton will improve the intersection of Scona Road and Saskatchewan Drive.

To complete this work the project may need to reduce traffic on Scona Road to one lane in each direction at various times over the duration of the project. Additional closures on Saskatchewan Drive, including nighttime and offpeak directional closures, will also be required. Construction is scheduled to begin sometime within the next few weeks and will be completed by fall 2020.

Scope of Work

- Removal of the northwest and southwest pedestrian islands.
- Reconfiguration of the south bound right turn bay onto Saskatchewan Drive from Scona Road.
- Sidewalk and shared-use path replacement.
- Asphalt milling, surface paving and landscaping.
- New installations and repairs to the storm manholes and catch basins.
- New traffic signals and street lights as required.

Access

During the construction period, local access will be maintained at all times. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times, however some detours may be required. Access to schools, businesses and residences will be maintained, where possible, at all times. Emergency access will be maintained at all times.
