

### WHAT'S HAPPENING?

There are two catchbasins which are connected to an outfall that are in need rehabilitation. The outfall is located near 87 Avenue and 97 Street, on top of the Mill Creek Ravine, and services the Strathcona neighbourhood.

This construction will involve the partial installation of new pipes to connect the catchbashins to the outfall. In addition, a silt fence will also be installed for erosion protection.

#### **HOURS OF WORK**

Typical hours of operation will be from **7:00am to 7:00pm, Monday to Saturday**. If required, these hours may be extended, and construction may occur on Sundays from 9:00am to 5:00pm.

EPCOR will do everything possible to manage noise associated with the construction and will work to ensure that the construction is completed within the requirements of the City of Edmonton Noise Bylaw.

#### **SCHEDULE**

The construction is scheduled to begin within the next month, as soon as Alberta One-Call locates have been completed. The work is expected to be completed within three weeks from when construction starts, weather permitting.

#### COVID-19

EPCOR is closely monitoring the situation related to the COVID-19 outbreak. Protocols have been put in place for our employees while performing essential work to protect the health of our teams and our customers. We also request homeowners take precautionary measures by maintaining a safe, two meter distance from our crews.

We would like to reassure our customers that we have plans in place to manage disruptions or emergencies, and are committed to providing the services our communities count on.

#### **SAFETY**

The construction areas will be fenced and/or marked as restricted areas. We will take every precaution to ensure public safety, and we request your assistance in keeping children and pets a safe distance from the construction site and the equipment.

# **CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS**

During construction, there are no anticipated full road closures. In addition:

- Residents may expect periodic closures of the north curb lane on 87 Avenue, along the green space, for staging area of material delivery and equipment.
  The laydown area will be dependent on the City of Edmonton Neighbourhood Renewal work currently happening in the neighbourhood.
- The trail and staircase will remain open at all times.
- Flag people will be used to notify trail users/residents when equipment is moving in the area, and directing trail users from the top and bottom of the staircase.
- Residents may experience some noise as a number of construction equipment will be used for material delivery, excavation, and surface restoration.
- All affected landscaping will be restored to their original condition. Once construction has been completed, residents can expect to see the area remain fenced for several weeks to allow the seeding to establish. Restoration will be completed by fall 2020 as weather permits.
