Submissions to the Contest must be received by **Friday February 3rd, 2023 at 11:59:59 p.m. MST** in order to be eligible.

ENTRY: Each Contestant will need to prepare 800 grams of dry weight pasta (Regular or Gluten Free) & sufficient accompanying sauce (At discretion of the Contestant).

Categories of Sauces judged are the following:

- 1. Best meat-based sauce
- 2. Best vegetarian sauce
- 3. Best alternative sauce

Contestants will be responsible for providing ingredients, serving utensils, and a crockpot with extension cord or method of keeping the food warm. Food must be kept at or above 60 degrees Celsius & must reach at least 74 degrees Celsius if being reheated.

WINNER SELECTION: A panel of judges will select and award three (3) entries (Per category) with First Place through Third Place Prizes based on adherence to these Official Rules and the following Recipe criteria, which shall be weighted equally: Taste, Appearance, and Originality. Contestants may enter in more than 1 category.
